Through the worship service we hear the voices of the Vanuatu

women, located in the South Pacific Ocean who invite us to focus on the Bible story in Matthew 7:24-27. Jesus tells a story about the kingdom of heaven using the image of a house and the land on which the house is built. Choosing the land on which to build a house in this area is an important decision for people in Vanuatu. The combination of considering the terrain and the climate is crucial as the area is prone to earthquakes, cyclones, volcanic eruptions and rising sea levels. On 6th April 2020, Vanuatu was hit by Cyclone Harold, which had made its way across the Pacific destroying many islands in its wake.
