**Dublin, Ireland,** has been chosen by Pope Francis to host the next World Meeting of Families in August 2018. Started by Saint John Paul II, and held every three years, this major world event celebrates family as the cornerstone of our lives, and the fundamental building block of society and the Church.

Families and others from all over the world will gather in Dublin from 21-26 August 2018 to celebrate their lives together, to share their experiences from different parts of the world, to reflect on the different challenges they face and to grow together in faith.

The theme chosen by Pope Francis for WMOF2018 is *The* Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World. The WMOF2018 Logo, launched in December 2016, reflects on this theme and our journey towards August 2018. We will explore the meaning behind the logo in future issues of the newsletter.

The WMOF2018 is more than a once-off event. Rather it is a process by which we can celebrate and explore the riches of the Church's "Gospel of the Family". This is why a programme of catechesis/faith education is being developed to prepare for the event, which draws largely from the Apostolic Exhortation Amoris Laetitia (The Joy of Love). The *Amoris*: Let's talk about family Programme will be an interactive

multimedia catechetical platform of resources. We hope that this programme will be used by many families, individuals and groups, local Churches and across the world.

If you have any ideas of how we should prepare for and celebrate the World Meeting of Families in the parish, please let us know.


